- **Upon a motion by Tiffany Csontos, seconded by Emily Haley, the October 2022 meeting minutes are unanimously approved.**

Updates:

- **Little Free Library:** Vanessa Repicky reports that October was a great month for the Little Free library, giving away approximately 80 books. Books for November and January were ordered through Scholastic.
- **Pumpkin Contest:** The pumpkin carving contest had 70 participants and slideshows of the entries were enjoyed at school.
- **Hats on for Soldiers:** Hats on for Soldiers raised \$274, a check will be issued to Operation Adopt a Soldier.
- **Grant Application:** Vanessa Repicky applied for a \$325 grant to Walmart to fund a 4th grade field trip to the Iroquois museum.

Event Updates:

- **Boosterthon:** Kelly Seamster reports that we reached our goal for the run-a-thon although we will need to check with the treasurer on the exact amount. Kelly will confirm if absent students still donated. Emily Haley volunteered for the event and reported that there was great weather and the students had fun. Emily recommends inviting more parent volunteers next year to help in shifts, much like field day. Discussion on logistics of taping Mrs. Polikoski to the wall during the November 22nd assembly. One volunteer from EPTSO to attend, TBD.
- **Bus Trip:** Vanessa Repicky reported that the deposit was mailed for the Yankee Trails bus trip in April and the contract we signed.
