Selection Criteria for Wall of Fame Alumni Award

1. The nominations shall be submitted on a completed nomination form available upon request from the Superintendent's Office at the District Office, telephone number (518) 295-6679. The Selection Committee may request additional information about the nominee.
2. Nominations shall be kept on file by the Selection Committee to be considered each subsequent year. Nominations are due by January 1st of each year.
3. In order to qualify as a candidate for the Alumni Wall of Fame Award, the individual shall have graduated Schoharie High School and shall be at least a 15-year high school graduate. Exceptions to the 15-year rule may be considered by the Selection Committee in the event of premature death of the nominee.
4. Qualifying candidates for the Alumni Wall of Fame Award shall have made a significant, lasting contribution to society or the school district; have exhibited good citizenship; demonstrated outstanding leadership; and have high moral character.
5. Records shall be kept, consisting of a résumé and, if available, a picture of all individuals selected for the Alumni Award. These records will be kept with the Alumni Wall of Fame Selection Committee records in the Superintendent's Office.
6. The selection committee decides upon the number of Alumni Wall of Fame awards that are given each year, after reviewing the nominees.
7. A nomination not chosen will be left on file for five years and will be considered for the following year(s) up to but not exceeding five years.
8. The District will dedicate a page in the high school yearbook to the Wall of Fame recipients that year (photo if possible and article). A certificate prepared by the District and a free copy of the yearbook will be presented to the individual(s) who is/are honored. The person or persons making the nomination may be responsible for the financial costs of the Wall of Fame plaque which is placed on display in the school.
9. Presentation of the Alumni Wall of Fame Award shall be made on Homecoming weekend each year. In addition, the award and photo (if available) will be placed in the Wall of Fame section of the District website.
